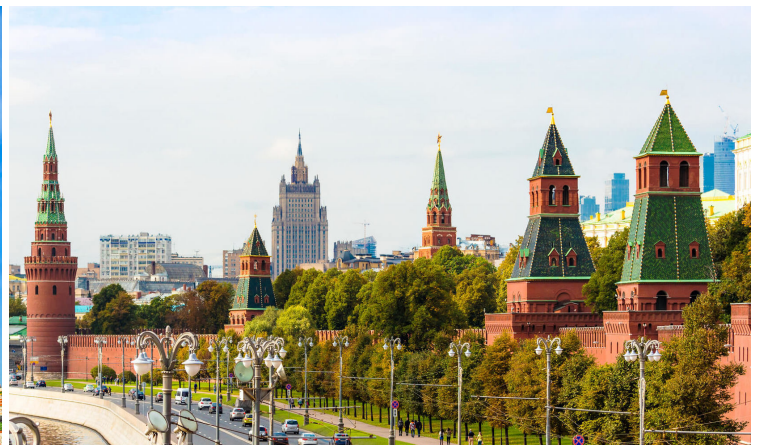
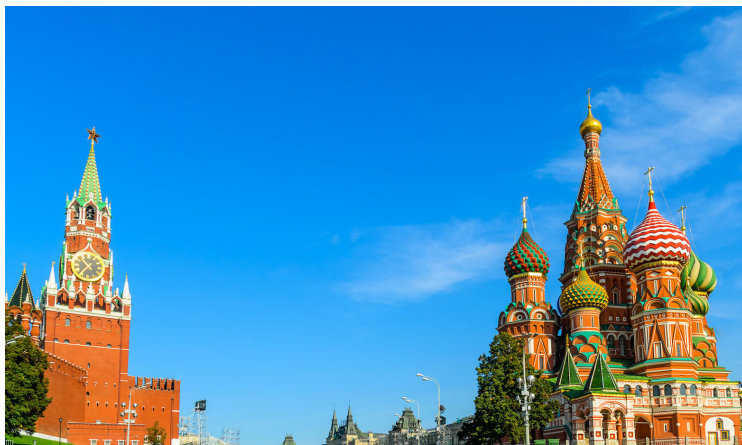

- City tour on the way to the hotel, transfer to the hotel and check-in.

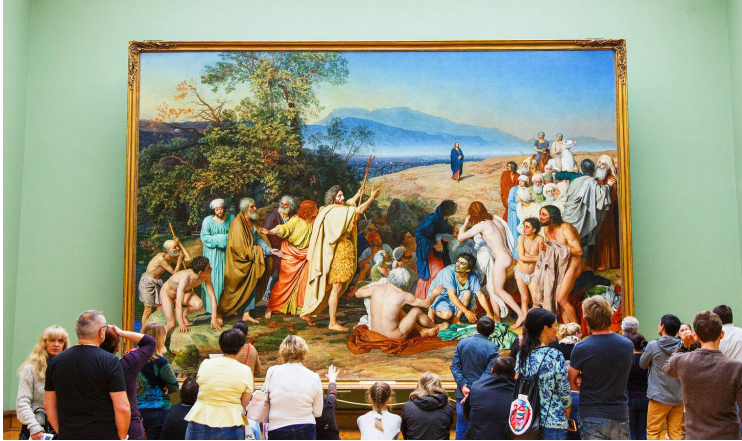
## Day 2

- Pick up from hotel, departure to Catherine’s Palace at Pushkin.
- Visit the world famous Amber Room and other amazing rooms of the Imperial Palace.
- Visit Peterhof, tour of the stunning fountains and beautiful gardens.

- Visit Peter and Paul fortress, which is situated in the small island called “Hare Island”.
- Visit the Colonnade in St. Isaac’s Cathedral, to experience the bird’s eye view of the city.
- Visit Faberge Museum, famous for the collection of nine Imperial Easter eggs.
- Visit Russian Vodka Museum.
- At midnight, boat ride to see the bridge opening.

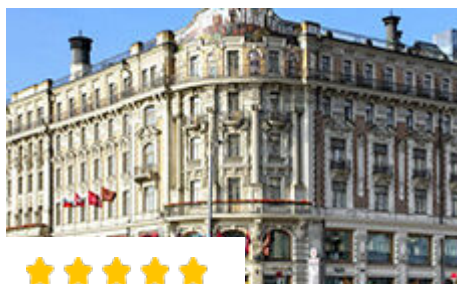

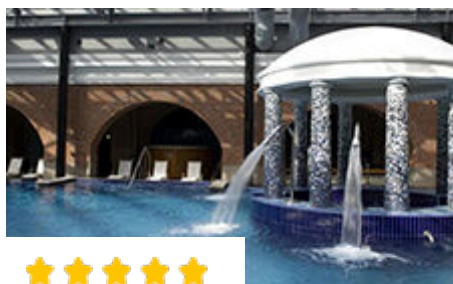
